La Quinta Vida Nueva is a guesthouse run by Jeff and Kristi Link. This ministry's purpose is to provide a safe, comfortable place for work teams cooperating with the ministry of the church in Nicaragua. We appreciate your support and cooperation.

1. **We provide** bedding, towels, soap, and toilet paper. Let the maid know if you need more than is provided.
2. **The people who work** here are here to serve you and enjoy doing so. Mercedes is the cook, Jessica cleans and does the wash. Ivan is the caretaker of the grounds and the guard. Tipping them is appreciated, but optional.
3. **It would be very much appreciated** if you would observe the following:
 - a) No smoking or alcoholic beverages on the premises.
 - b) Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 6 am. Your group may not be the only one here, and others, including our neighbors, will appreciate your consideration.
 - c) Please do not remove dishes, bedding, pillows, fans, or mattresses from the premises.
 - d) Turn off the lights and fans when you leave. Our power bills are very high, and we thank you for keeping that in mind.
 - e) If you are the last ones to leave the house please close all doors.
 - f) All groups are given a key to the front door. The caretakers will open the gate for you.
 - g) If you are the last one to bed, please close al, doors and turn off lights and fans in the living are.
 - h) The windows can be opened to ventilate your room.
4. **Kitchen use:** Please take care of it as you would at your home. Wash to dishes you use. return dishes to the kitchen area. Report and pay for what you damage. As you can see, we have only limited space for refrigeration of your personal items.
5. **Meals:**
 - a) We provide bottled water for your use on the premises only.
 - b) Normal mealtime is breakfast at 7 am and dinner at 6 pm. If you return late in the evening, the cooks will expect you to serve your own meal and store any leftover food. Arrange your meal schedule with the cook. On Sunday we make breakfast and lunch if you wish. Any meals ordered and not eaten will be charged to your group unless you give sufficient notice.
 - c) Salad greens are prepared with iodine, and fruits are carefully washed. Drinks and ice are prepared with bottled water.
6. **Prices:** Overnight lodging is \$11.00. AC is \$25.00 additional pre night if used. Please keep track of your own use of the AC. If you travel out of town and leave your things in the room, you will be charged for that night's lodging unless you make previous arrangements. Meals: Breakfast is \$4.00 and dinner is \$5.00. You may invite guests, but need to let the cook know ahead of time and pay accordingly. Drivers, Translators,

etc. are considered your guests. Laundry: is \$3.00 a dozen if we wash it. Put it in a plastic bag and leave it in the laundry area and it will be returned there by the next day. No laundry on Sundays, please. If you want to use the washer or dryer, you may when our workers are not using them. You provide your own soap. Washer will be \$2.00 a load. Dryer will be \$2.00 a load. Hang your clothes outside at your own risk.

7. **Repairs**: We appreciate it when you report the need for a repair on the grounds. Tell the maid or cook who will contact us.
